

Institute of Medical Science Entrance Award for International Students

The Institute of Medical Science Graduate Coordinators' Entrance Award is designed to attract top international students to IMS. International applicants applying to our doctoral stream (MSc and PhD programs) may apply for this award. To be considered, you must submit your completed graduate studies application for September registration to the Institute of Medical Science by **February 1**. Students will receive this award only once. Students funded by their home government or in receipt of an international scholarship are not eligible.

Terms and Conditions of Eligibility:

In order to be eligible for this Award, applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- a) Demonstrates exceptional academic achievement.
- b) Provides a letter describing the significance of his/her previous scientific work.
- c) Fully describe your proposed research project/plan.
- d) Provides a letter from an IMS faculty member indicating his/her willingness to fund and supervise the research thesis program.

Value and Duration

- a) The value of the award is \$10,000.
- b) The award is given to an international student upon first entry to IMS.
- c) This award is non-renewable.
- d) This award will be considered part of the annual student stipend.

Adjudication and Results:

Applications will be reviewed by the Graduate Coordinators. Awardees and supervisors will be notified in writing no later than April 15th.

Payment:

Payment of this award will be directed toward the student's tuition.
